Opening Prayer: The meeting was called to order with an opening prayer at 7:05 pm.

Opening remarks: meeting minutes need posting on web-site.

Approval of Minutes: June 17th meeting minutes approved via e-mail.

Review of Financial Statements through 7/2009:

Income Statement:

Income:

Total Collection income: \$42K YTD

Expenses:

- Total repairs & maintenance \$5K, (+) \$0.4, (+)7% to PYTD
- Total Expenses: \$90.3K Year to date actual

Net income/loss: (-)\$28.2K Year to date actual, (-) \$2.4K unfavorable to PYTD. Directionally consistent with prior years, timing issues with fiscal year income backloaded.

Capital Campaign: \$30K total income. 5 year pledges expire in January 2010

Parish Reserves: Was 21K, after \$11K HVAC and \$5K floor maintenance balance now \$5K. Parking lot resurfacing/restriping expense was planned for October and may need to be delayed. \$1K a month expected to be replenishing the reserves.

August 19, 2009

Budget: Plan will be consistent with prior year. Prior year-end result was \$17K favorable. This primarily thanks

to "Did You Know Campaign" and the Parish Golf Tournament.

Proposed Budget:

Total income and expenses planned flat to prior year.

- Key activities are consistent YOY.
- Due to economic outlook, budget was planned conservatively.
- As in prior years, planning for a typical cycle of income being short in the first 6 months of the financial year and then leveling out in the second half.
- Other comments made: No cost increases from Diocese, no changes in payroll (no cost of living increases planned), some increases in insurance expenses.

Old business: Jim Mc Glone provided a memo on Status of Fixed Asset Inventory dated 8-18-09, recommending use Of an outsource firm. They will provide the council an estimate of costs for their inventory services.

New business:

a) Nina addressed update on Financial Reports:

They will not be printed this year in order to save the expense.

The reports will be posted on the parish web site.

b) October Meeting: Moving from planned date of the 21st to new date: October 28th, 2009

Building and Maintenance: Nothing under this category

Personnel Report: Henrietta Black was approved by unanimous vote as new money counter.

Update from Pastoral Council:

Vacancy in Marriage & Family Life.

Goal is to target young couples who don't have children or are not in religious education.

There are 6 couples so far, Jennifer Frost designated at chair.

About 100 parishioners have been identified as potential members of this new group -- ACTTS-- Adult

Catholics in their Twenties and Thirties who Socialize.

Update from Development Council: Covered by Fr. Mike (see below)

Comments from the Pastor:

Fr. Mike reported on his meeting with Diocese regarding the church build out. Met with Monsignor Callahan, Jerry Mills (Director of Finance) and Dan Rancor (sp?) (Construction).

Discussion key points:

- Good time to build \$1M in possible savings
- Prepared to adjust/make exception on debt service ratio requirement. Need \$5M on deposit to borrow to required levels.
- Diocese support complete build-out of all buildings and plans
- Follow-up meeting planned by Chris to update and plan Capital campaign, pledges. \$1.8M is needed as soon as possible.

Charters/Policies:

Finance council charter, Pastoral council charter and personnel policy submitted to Diocese.

Minor repairs:

- Discussed low cost options and motion was approved to recondition rectory

Closing Prayer: There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned with a prayer by Father Mike at 7:50PM
