Finance Council

Offertory collections are up 4% from what was budgeted last year. Even with last year's \$28K deficit rolled over we should break even due to expected proceeds from the Golf Classic, Flea Market, Did You Know Campaign, etc.

Development Council

Restaurant Fundraising has slowed down slightly.

Vehicle Donation program has brought in \$21K overall with four new vehicles now being processed.

Social Ministries

The first Social Ministries Retreat was held Sat. March 19th. Each ministry was asked to give a four-minute talk explaining its mission and operation, and also how to relay this information better to the whole parish. The group felt this should be an annual event.

Blood Drive was held on Sun., May 22nd.

CPR Program celebrated its 10th anniversary at STM. A new course, Hands-Only CPR, will be offered twice a month starting in June.

Culture of Life sponsored a very successful baby food drive in May for Birth Choice, collecting an abundance of food plus \$300 in cash.

Fraternity House & Michaele House: More's Workers has agreed to repair and paint the living room and kitchen. Dave Parks is the team leader.

Just Faith: most participants completed the 30-week program. The closing retreat was May 14th at Mission San Luis Rey, with participation from STM, St. Francis, St. Peter, St. James and St. Patrick's. The program will be offered again next year.

North County Solutions for Change: Parish fundraising appeal is scheduled for Aug. 6th & 7th. There is some difficulty getting volunteers for monthly meals.

Social Justice Committee: STM hosted the North County Interfaith "Reflection on Immigration" on April 30th, with an attendance of 120.

Prayer Request Line: There is a need for more individuals on the phone tree. A suggestion was made to possibly use e-mail to elicit help but it would need to be overseen by an individual other than office staff.

The Annual Catholic Appeal assessment for STM is \$48K, \$46K of which has been collected. A second mailing is in progress.

Stewardship weekend will be moved to January. Since this coincides with the end of phase II of the Capital Campaign, an interim plan will need to be in place to continue the acquisition of funds for our new loan. It will hopefully be closer to

groundbreaking as well. The format for Stewardship Awareness will remain the same.

An exciting meeting with the interior design team and the staff was recently held focusing on both the interior and exterior design. The next day, both the architect and liturgical consultant worked together fine-tuning the interior plans.

The next quarterly meeting with the diocese will be in September with groundbreaking most likely in early 2012.
