- 10:30 session (PRE-K) has 27 students with 4 catechists and 2 teen assistants

- Gun Violence Protection: Fr. Mike will focus on this issue for an upcoming Pastor's column and an insert in the bulletin put out by PICO

Liturgy

• Advent – Attendance at the 12/16 Reconciliation Service increased this year. Date was later in Advent than usual. Need stations set up to provide more privacy for penitents. Perhaps information in the worship aid will prevent lines from forming

Advent wreath – wreath will be retired after 10:30 Mass on the 4th Sunday of Advent and not displayed during Christmas.

Nativity Manger and animals were installed the 4th week of Advent. Good help from parishioners after 10:30 Mass to set rest of figures and other A&E décor

• **Christmas** - 4PM Christmas Eve Mass – Besides the 200 rented chairs, about 100 extra were brought outside from the lower level .

Seat reservation for 4PM mass needs to be discouraged - announcements will be made at 15 minute intervals to remind those who are holding seats that they need to be filled.

Q: Can Communion be taken outside? A: Everyone who is able needs to come to the Altar. Location of Nativity and blessing by Fr. Mike was well received. Many families took photosMass Settings need to be joyful for Christmas. Choir is adding more choices and will eventually have at least 7 to choose from.

Art work needs to be level – was distracting

Prefer that the Altar cloth be hung side-to-side rather than front to back.

Bells were missed at Christmas!

• Apostle's Creed:

Instead of the Nicene Creed, STM will use the Apostles' Creed this year during Lent and Easter

• Announcements at Mass:

Announcements are part of the liturgy, but the staff will make every effort to streamline the number and edit appropriately for Reader #3

• Ministry reports/comments:

Kathleen Bell – expressed need for alternate Baptismal font for Easter to accommodate taller individuals (over 6 ft.) Kathy will bring the A&E Team together to come up with some options. Joyce Meehan – Phase I Confirmation students will have more formal training and expects there to be 3-4 per Mass.

• Ministry training – February 2, 2013

Expect attendance to be smaller this year as the Diocese is scheduling training for the first time in several years. Attendance requires enrollment and payment. For Ministers of the Word it is a 2-part training and enrollment will be limited.

Fr. Mike mentioned that the transition from Capital Campaign to Mortgage Offering is going smoothly and parishioners are responding favorably.

Bishop Flores hosted a Stewardship and luncheon meeting at the Pastoral Center on Wednesday, January 23, encouraging Parishes to engage in stewardship and development at the local level in every Parish. January has been Christian Stewardship Month here at STM. Fr. Mike's homily, and the lay witness talk by Kevin and Kristin McCusker were well received. Next Sunday, Brian Leahey, Director of Construction, and Chris Smith, Director of Stewardship and Development, will give updates before all Masses.

The Town Hall Meeting to inform parishioners about the interior elements of the Church is scheduled for this Friday, January 25 at 6:30PM

The San Diego Organizing Project (SDOP) of which STM is a member is beginning to meet around the issue of immigration reform in preparation for the proposed legislation from Congress that should be made known soon.

Fr. Mike and Sr. Maureen attended a SDOP sponsored meeting regarding gun violence and discussion regarding possible gun control legislation. Fr. Mike said that he would share his own personal views in a future Pastor's Column
