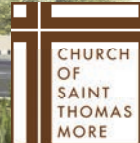

Pastor's Column *(continued from page 1)*

John and Debbie are now completing an intense five-year preparation for his ordination. It is important to note that the wife of a Deacon-Candidate partners her husband throughout the entire five-year process of academic classes, prayer sessions, and retreats. This is so that the Deacon's wife knows precisely what will be involved in the life and ministry of the Deacon.

As many in our Parish know, Debbie and John and their daughters, Madison, Grace, and Anna, are already very involved in the ministerial life of our Parish. And with John's ordination, we look forward to even more deepened involvement.

John and Debbie also have two adult daughters: Shawna who lives with her husband, Aaron, and their two children in Texas, and Meghan who lives in Washington DC.

It is also important to note that a Permanent Deacon maintains his present job/career and that his ministry in a Parish is done without a salary or pay. Saying this, one can better understand the commitment that a deacon and his wife make in accepting God's call to the Permanent Diaconate.

I am putting John "to work" immediately! Deacon John will preach at all three Masses one weekend a month, every month; he will continue to oversee the Parish Men's Ministry that he has helped to begin; he will celebrate Communion Services at the four Assisted Living Facilities for which we are responsible—Ægis at Shadowridge, Emeritus at Oceanside, Emeritus at Carlsbad, and Pacific Place; he will be a part of our Baptismal process and will be interviewing the parents presenting their children for Infant Baptism; and he will alternate with Deacon Tom in celebrating the monthly Baptisms. Deacon John will also be available for any appointments that Parishioners may wish to set up with him.

The weekend of May 25, 26, and 27 will be a weekend of great joy for our Parish. The Ordination is at 4:00pm on Friday, May 25, at St. Thérèse of Carmel in San Diego.

Deacon John will preach at all the Masses on May 26 and 27.

After the 5:00pm Mass on May 26, there will be a dinner in honor of the Fredette family with Parish Staff and Leadership. (This is by invitation only.)

Then, after the 10:30am Mass on Sunday, May 27, there will be a Parish reception on the Plaza.

For most of our Parishioners, the time to meet, greet, and thank our new Deacon will be at the reception on the Plaza after the 10:30am Mass on May 27. Please stop by!

Deacon John, Debbie, Madison, Grace, and Anna, you are a boon to the Faith Community of St. Thomas More!



And we give a special "Thank You" to John and Debbie's son, Owen, who died in 2007 at the age of 11. Owen, in his short lifetime, did much to help prepare his parents for lives of service!

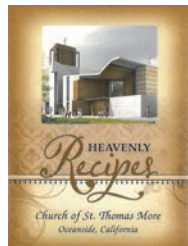

Immigration Survey: A Snapshot of Our Parish

In 2011 our Parish hosted an Immigration Reflection Day attended by members of many congregations throughout North County. It was a wonderful experience for each of us sharing our family immigration stories. Listening to each other's stories helped us get in touch with what we held in common and what was unique to each family. Through the use of a time line, we were able to see from which countries we had come to the United States and when—from early times to the present.

Although we cannot replicate that day, the Parish Social Justice Committee is offering a survey to our Parishioners to help us get a "snapshot" of the history of our Parish families, so that we too can celebrate who we are and from where we have come. In the survey, we are asking questions about you and your family and the way they came to the United States. From the results, we will compile some facts and stories that we will share with you in the Parish bulletin. Ultimately, we would like to work out a time line to show how we all came to be in this place, at this time.

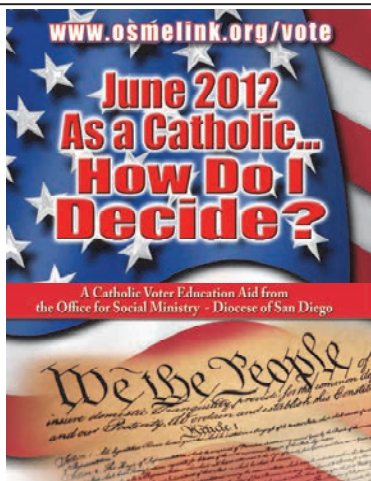

THE DEACON AND THE LITURGY

Next weekend, the Church of St. Thomas More will have a second deacon.

John Fredette will be ordained this week, joining Tom Goeltz as part of the sacred order of the diaconate. As part of his ministry, John will assist Fr. Mike (and other priests) in a variety of liturgical activities.

At the Mass, the deacon has his own part in the entrance procession, in proclaiming the Gospel, in preaching God's word from time to time, in announcing the intentions of the Prayer of the Faithful, in ministering to the priest, in preparing the altar and serving the celebration of the Sacrifice, in distributing the Eucharist to the faithful, especially under the species of wine, and sometimes in giving directions regarding the people's gestures and posture.

Deacons also can preside at weddings and baptisms.

We pray for John, and his wife Debbie, as John begins ordained ministry at St. Thomas More, and for Deacon Tom and his wife Patt, who will be celebrating the 12th anniversary of his ordination on June 2:

O God, who have taught the ministers of your Church to seek not to be served but to serve their brothers and sisters, grant, we pray, that these your servants ... may be effective in action, gentle in ministry, and constant in prayer.

Through our Lord, Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, for ever and ever. Amen.
