Pastor's Column

Feast of St. Thomas More

Thomas More wrote the following letter to his daughter Margaret with a charcoal stick. It was written from prison on July 5, 1535, the day before he was executed.

Our Lord bless you, good daughter, and your good husband, and your little boy, and all yours, and all my children, and all my god-children and all our friends. Recommend me when ye may to my good daughter Cecily, whom I beseech Our Lord to comfort; and I send her my blessing and to all her children, and pray her to pray for me. I send her a handkercher, and God comfort my good son, her husband. My good daughter Daunce hath the picture in parchment that you delivered me from my Lady Coniers, her name on the back. Show her that I heartily pray that you may send it in my name to her again, for a token from me to pray for me.

I like special well Dorothy Colly. I pray you be good unto her. I would wot whether this be she that you wrote me of. If not, yet I pray you be good to the other as you may in her affliction, and to my good daughter Jane Aleyn too. Give her, I pray you, some kind answer, for she sued hithereto me this day to pray you be good to her.

I cumber you, good Margaret, much, but I would be sorry if it should be any longer than to-morrow, for it is St. Thomas's even, and the utas of St. Peter; and therefore, to-morrow long I to go to God. It were a day very meet and convenient for me.

I never liked your manner towards me better than when you kissed me last; for I love when daughterly love and dear charity hath no leisure to worldly courtesy. Farewell, my dear child, and pray for me, and I shall for you and all your friends, that we may merrily meet in heaven. I thank you for your great cost. I send now my good daughter Clement here algorism stone, and I send her and my godson and all hers God's blessing and mine. I pray you at time convenient recommend me to my good son John More. I liked well his natural fashion. Our Lord bless him and his good wife, my loving daughter, to whom I pray him to be good, as he hath great cause; and that, if the land of mine come to his hands, he break not my will concerning his sister Daunce. And the Lord bless Thomas and Austin, and all that they shall have.

As we celebrate our Patron Saint, we are mindful that he was a real "family-man." In this letter we see how he expresses his great fatherly concern for the ongoing welfare of his family!

St. Thomas More is, indeed, a "Man for all Seasons."

Eight of our Parishioners gathered at Friendship Park, near the Tijuana Border, this past Saturday to support Sr. Simone Campbell, executive director of the national Catholic social-justice lobby, NETWORK, and other nuns in their advocacy for Immigration Reform. They made this stop to spread their message as part of a 6,500 mile national bus tour to Congressmen, other political officials, religious and secular groups.



Sr. Simone said they wanted to stop at the Border to emphasize “that this border (would be) better if it's constructed not with fences but with good laws.” These advocates are trying to influence the White House and Congress to enact a fair, just, and compassionate Immigration Law. 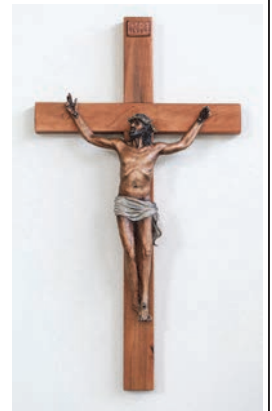

EUCHARIST AND ST. THOMAS MORE

Light, Wisdom, Counsel, and Prudence

This weekend, at the Saturday evening and Sunday morning Masses, we celebrate the feast of our Patron Saint, Thomas More. His feast day is officially June 22, but parishes may opt to observe the feast of their patron saint on either the preceding or following Sunday, if that day is a Sunday in Ordinary Time. In some years, like this one, the calendar falls such that we can celebrate on Sunday, in other years the celebrations of the Body and Blood of Christ or Trinity Sunday supersede the patronal feast.

This year, it seems serendipitously appropriate that we are celebrating our patron's feast day as equipment begins the great work of building our permanent worship space. For it is *in* church and *as* Church—whether gathered in the permanent space to come or the temporary spaces of our past and present—that we receive the great gift the Eucharist, which is the source and summit of Christian life. Moreover, it is so very clear from his writings that our patron considered the Eucharist as critical to his faith, and to his ability to maneuver his way through the trials and tribulations of everyday life.

If I am distracted, Holy Communion helps me to become recollected. If opportunities are offered by each day to offend my God, I arm myself anew each day for the combat by the reception of the Eucharist. If I am in special need of light and prudence in order to discharge my burdensome duties, I draw nigh to my Savior and seek counsel and light from him.

Some of Thomas More's friends would take him to task over the frequency of his going to Mass as his life was so very busy and his duties demanding. His response is enlightening.

Your reasons for wanting me to stay away from Holy Communion are exactly the ones which cause me to go so often. My distractions are great, but it is in Communion that I recollect myself. I have temptations many times a day; by daily Communion I get the strength to overcome them. I have much very important business to handle and I need light and wisdom; it is for this reason that I go to Holy Communion every day to consult Jesus about them.

Holy Communion, Eucharist, source and summit of our Christian life, source of counsel and wisdom and light, opportunity to recollect oneself through the Body and Blood of our Lord. As we take our patron's words to heart, know also that the opportunity to serve our Parish, to minister to this faith community as

an Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion, is available to all confirmed Parishioners.

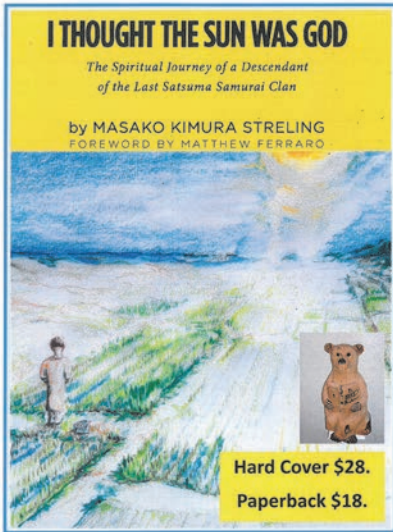

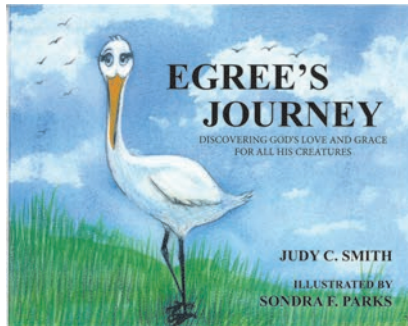
The author of this book is our very own Parishioner, Masako Streling. Since it was recently published, many of our Parish family have been looking forward to reading it.
