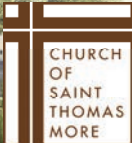

### We Are Workers

It helps, now and then, to step back and take a long view. The kingdom is not only beyond our efforts, it is even beyond our vision.

We accomplish in our lifetime only a tiny fraction of the magnificent enterprise that is God's work. Nothing we do is complete, which is a way of saying that the kingdom always lies beyond us.

No statement says all that could be said.  
No prayer fully expresses our faith.  
No confession brings perfection.  
No pastoral visit brings wholeness.  
No program accomplishes the church's mission.  
No set of goals and objectives includes everything.

This is what we are about.  
We plant the seeds that one day will grow.  
We water seeds already planted,  
knowing that they hold future promise.

We lay foundations that will need further development.  
We provide yeast that produces far beyond our capabilities.

We cannot do everything, and there is a sense of liberation

an opportunity for the Lord's grace to enter and do the rest.  
We may never see the end results, but that is the difference  
between the master builder and the worker.

## Christian Stewardship ~ A New Understanding

Because our daughter served with the Peace Corps in Albania, she speaks the Albanian language. Therefore, when ethnic Albanian refugees from Kosovo arrived in our community, our family volunteered to help them. We were assigned to a family that spoke only Albanian and no English.

The hardships this family had already endured were horrible. But they were now safely here and doing their best to start over. That's a difficult job for a family. The husband cooked at a fast food restaurant and tried to use his earnings to support his wife, his elderly mother, and four children, ages between 1 and 11. Like other volunteers we did our best to augment the "starter setup," which the refugee agency provided.

From friends and neighbors, we gathered household goods and clothing for them. Because they came from a farming village, they needed to learn many new skills such as how to use a telephone, run a washing machine, shop at the supermarket, understand the school system for their children, and other things too numerous to mention.

Of course, they did not have the money they needed. In their culture hospitality is very important. Each time we went to their home, they insisted on giving us something to eat or drink. It's difficult to accept such kindness from people who are living at a subsistence level. But it was more important to not insult them by declining what they offered.

One day when our daughter returned from delivering some things to them, she had four beautiful large bananas. The family had insisted she bring them home with her. Though they knew we were a family of three, they wanted us to have all four bananas. It was such a generous gift. And it was humbling to us.



Do you remember Jesus' story of the widow's mite? The coin she gave as her offering represented the very smallest amount of money. But she gave it lovingly and gratefully. We now have a new understanding of this biblical story.

Like that widow, our Kosovar family was giving to us from a very meager supply. But they gave their best . . . and with great love and gratitude. In loving concern we gave to them from our abundance. Proportionately, everything we did for them would never equal the four beautiful bananas they gave us.

We may have taught them a few things about living in America. They taught us about sacrificial giving.

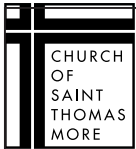



# Travel to Camp Pendleton Mechanized Museum and Ranch House Tours

Lunch at the  
**Pacific View All Service Club**  
(Asian Buffet with soup, salad, and ethnic dishes)



The Ranch House complex is listed as the Santa Margarita Ranch House National Historic Site as well as a California State Historical Landmark. It includes the Ranch House Chapel, the oldest structure on base, the Bunkhouse Museum, dedicated in 1978 by Col James Roosevelt, and the Ranch House, built in the mid 1800s. This was the home of Pio Pico, last governor of Mexican California, and succeeding owners. Historic artifacts at the complex document pre-history through Mission and Rancho periods, the 1942 purchase of Camp Pendleton, and reflect the WWII and the Korean War. Exhibits include early ranch equipment, photographs of President Roosevelt's historic visit, antiques donated by Anthony Quinn during the filming of "Guadalcanal Diary" in 1943 and early Base history including SSgt Reckless and the Mounted Color Guard.

The Mechanized Museum established in 1999 includes over 90 working Marine Corps transport and battle vehicles to interpret the history of Marine usage since 1942. The collection includes a large selection of Vietnam and Desert Storm era vehicles and a Vietnamese road marker from the road to Hue City. It is one of the largest and most unique collections of historical military vehicles in the United States.
