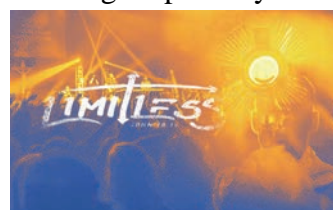

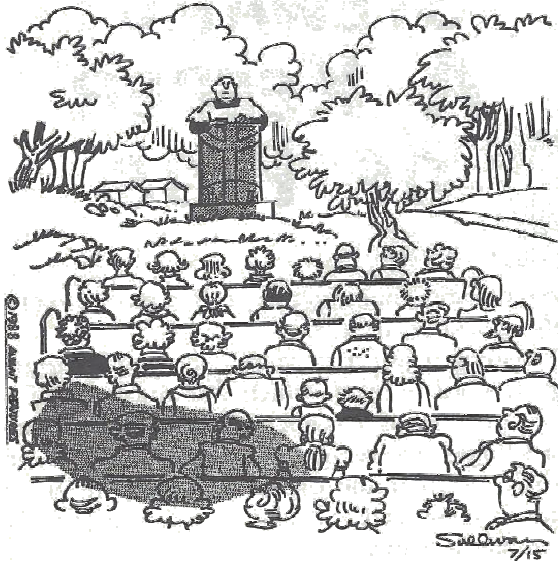

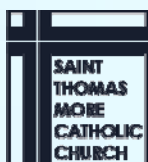

In March 2001, members of the St. Thomas More Parish developed a program to provide training and certification in CardioPulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the use of the Automated External Defibrillator (AED). Approximately 470 Parishioners have learned how to recognize a medical emergency, to summon first responders, and to support victims of heart attack, stroke, and other life-threatening conditions.

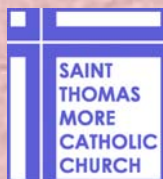

Our all-volunteer instructor team conducts Adult and Infant/Child classes most months of the year. These classes last about three hours and certification through the American Red Cross is valid for two years. The cost is \$37 per person and includes the latest American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED Manual.

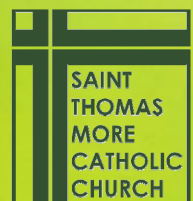
